CORRIGENDUM

Sir/Madam,

Kind attention is invited to the above-mentioned letters regarding CITS and CTS admission for the session 2022-23 in National Skill Training Institutes (NSTI).

2. In this regard, it is to inform that with the approval of Competent Authority, it has been decided that trades under Craft Instructor Training Scheme (CITS) and Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS) will be discontinued from the NSTIs where less than 10 students were admitted in the previous year 2021-22. For the session 2022-23, no admissions in these zero and low demand trades will be allowed in NSTIs. Further, it is also informed that no admission under CTS will be made in NSTI Bengaluru and NSTI (W), Bengaluru this year (2022).

3. Therefore, all RDSDEs and NSTIs are advised to strictly abide by the above instructions and carry out the admissions in their Institutes as per the revised seat matrix of CITS and CTS trades for the session 2022-23 attached herewith. All the Directors/HoDs and Principals of NSTIs are advised to upload the Notification (Corrigendum) on Institute's Websites for information to all stakeholders.
